

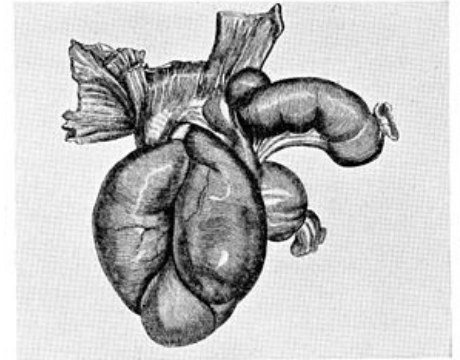
Strangulation

Strangulation is used in two senses:

1. *Squeezing the throat with an object* (throttle, hand) - according to the mechanism, we distinguish between strangulation, hanging, suffocation. Asphyxia occurs, death occurs by suffocation.
2. *Nerve vascular constriction* - causes non-bleeding and gangrene of the affected area (intestines).
