

Anomaly of the number and size of the teeth, supranumerary teeth (phylogenetic explanation)

Anomaly of the number of teeth

Decreased number of teeth

- Hypodontia - <6 teeth missing
- Oligodontia - >6 teeth missing
- Anodontia - All teeth missing. Associated with ectodermal dysplasias

Increased number of teeth

- Hyperdontia (supranumerary teeth)
1. Mesiodens - Lies between two central incisors
 2. Paramolars - Alongside with maxillary molars
 3. Distomolars - Located distally of third molars

Anomalies in size of teeth

- Macrodonia
- Microdonia
